New Business: Supervisor Johnston made a motion to continue working with the townships engineer Mid Penn on securing the grant seconded by Supervisor Nissly, (MCU). Supervisor Nissly made a motion to tar and chip Granger Lane and English Run Road seconded by Supervisor Pier, (MCU). Bank Signatories Supervisor Nissly will not be added to sign as he is not available. Supervisor Nissly made a motion to use the Lycoming County Pre-release Center program and pay them the rate of \$102.00 per day to clean the banks at Lick Run from debris Tropical Storm Debby washed up on the banks seconded by Supervisor Johnston, (MCU). Supervisor Nissly made a motion to go ahead with the grant work Rob was working on with County Conversation District and Trout Unlimited they will utilize the townships backhoe for some of the work seconded by

Supervisor Pier, (MCU). The township may rent a track loader to help with the work if they have an operator for its use to clean out the gravel bar under the Lick Run bridge. Larson Design Group T776 English Run Road plans were provided to keep the township, and forms were included for any public comment. Supervisor Johnston made a motion to approve Resolution 06.12.25 Document Disposal seconded by Supervisor Nissly, (MCU). Lycoming County Planning and Community Development request that the municipality adopt the Regional Solid Waste Management Plan for Lycoming County Supervisor Nissly is hesitant in making this decision as the municipality already has their own DEP approved facility in accordance with DEP's regulatory requirements.

Old Business: The Motter Agency Renewal proposal for the township. ATVs/UTV signage is being taken down and missing.
