Minutes:

Supervisor Johnston made a motion to accept the minutes as written for the Regular Meeting on February 9, 2023 and the Treasurer's Report for February 2023 seconded, by Supervisor Raudenbush, (MCU).

Vice Chairman Report – Motor Vehicle Weight Limitation and Bonding Ordinance topics and the townships responsibility to ensure our roads and bridges are maintained. Many rural townships like ours are experiencing issues with CDL operators/contractors not securing road bonds.

New Business: PennDOT notification of bridge replacement located on T-776 over English Run in Pine Township. Pine Township would be responsible for five percent of the overall cost, approximately \$71,750.00. The supervisors will figure the amount into the yearly budget. PennDOT highly recommends that the township allows PennDOT to administer and manage the project due to cost savings and time savings and listed the advantages with them administering and managing the local bridge project. Supervisor Raudenbush will contact Lycoming County Conservation District about funding available for the townships share of cost. Old Business: – Supervisor Raudenbush made a motion to bring in recycling containers and get a sign to be posted at facility with (DEP) permit -by-rule conditions seconded by Supervisor Johnston, (MCU). Alternate SEO tabled need more options. Supervisor Johnston made a motion to have the township’s solicitor Marc Drier to review and comment on the townships 2008 road weight limit ordinance and notify all known new haulers and large landowners a copy of the ordinance and attachments as done in the past. The supervisor will also set up a meeting with Municipal Solutions the township bonding authority to navigate the new board through the process of commonly asked questions and answers concerning the posting and bonding of weighted restricted highways seconded by Supervisor Raudenbush, (MCU).
